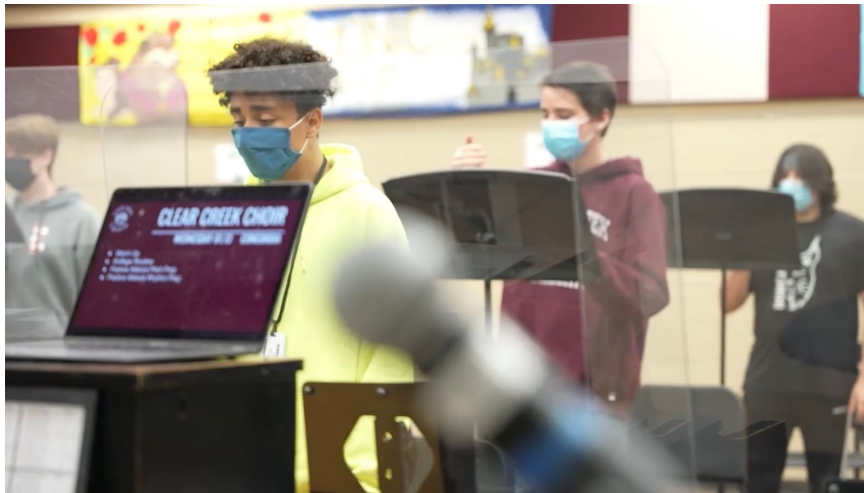
All State Results
