

**Clear Creek High School Choir
Solo and Ensemble Contest
on Friday, May 10th
at Clear Creek High School**

1. If a student is singing a solo for the competition, s/he must turn in \$30 fee by Tuesday, April 16th. **THERE WILL BE NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED AFTER THIS DATE.** The \$30 payment (made payable to CCHS Choir Boosters) is the student's commitment to following through with this process. Once s/he turns in this sheet with payment, s/he is obligated to participate as a soloist in the Solo & Ensemble Competition. **If s/he does not follow through with the commitment to sing at the Solo & Ensemble Competition, the student may not be considered for any Varsity level choirs for the following year AND will not be allowed to participate in any spring choir trips.** Once the money is turned in, there will be no refunds – NO EXCEPTIONS. (See refund policy in CCHS Choir Handbook.)
2. Students who turn in their contracts on Tuesday, April 16th may pick up a copy of their solo by Friday, April 19th. Student are encouraged to turn in his or her contract earlier to receive a solo before April 19th.
3. For students who would like to compete in the competition as a member of a small or medium ensemble only, must turn in \$30 fee by the same due date listed above. This fee is per ensemble, NOT per student.
4. Soloists will receive a recording with voice part and accompaniment and sheet music no later than Friday, April 19th.
5. ~~Students must be able to sing their solo **from memory** the week starting Monday, May 6th.~~
6. Students must bring their voice-part recordings and music to school **every day** in April and May.
7. Students who take private lessons will work with their voice teacher, and students who do not have voice teachers should schedule times to work with Mr. Park or Mr. Stultz. They are available to work on a limited basis with students taking voice lessons – please make an appointment to do so if interested. All soloists will be assigned an accompanist, and each student will rehearse at least twice with his/her accompanist before the contest.
8. **Students who take voice lessons are responsible for bringing an original copy of their music to the contest.** Directors will supply original copies of music for the students who are not in voice lessons.
9. The week before the contest is a very busy one. Do not wait until the last minute to schedule times to rehearse with Mr. Park and Mr. Stultz! We will have voluntary after school one-on-one rehearsals from April 22nd - 25th for those that would like additional help.
